

II PAOLO BOZZI PRIZE FOR A RESEARCH ON THE TOPIC OF "EXPERIMENTAL PHENOMENOLOGY"

CONTEST REGULATIONS

1 Establishment

On the occasion of 23rd Scientific Conference of the Society for Gestalt Theory and its Applications (GTA) to be held September 25-27, 2024, the Italian Network for Experimental Phenomenology in agreement with the Society for Gestalt Theory and its Applications, resolved to establish a prize for research conducted on the topic of "Experimental Phenomenology from the Historical, Theoretical and Experimental Perspective", in the amount of €1000.

2 Purpose of the competition

The competition aims to award research works with the purpose of enhancing the tradition inaugurated by Paolo Bozzi and his figure as a scholar.

3 Recipients

The awards are reserved for research papers that have as their subject matter issues related to experimental phenomenology declined in the most diverse philosophical-psychological fields. Recipients are those who have carried out research in one of these areas.

4 Judging Committee and Criteria

The judging committee will be chaired by Prof. Tiziano Agostini (University of Trieste) and will be composed of Prof. Mauro Antonelli (President of the Conference, University of Milano Bicocca) and Prof. Fabrizio Sors (University of Trieste).

For the awarding of the prize, the judging committee will evaluate, for each candidate:

- the methodological rigor and originality of the proposed research;
- the clarity of the content, the use of appropriate technical language and the quality of the written production as a whole.

The judgments of the committee and the final ranking will be unchallengeable.

5 Submission of applications

Applicants should submit their application via e-mail by sending the following documents:

- application form, duly completed and signed
- curriculum vitae et studiorum
- copy of the research work
- identity document of the registrant

Files should be in PDF format and named as per the example below.

Applications must be submitted via email to ThomasFuchsPsycho@t-online.de, by July 31, 2024.

Incomplete and/or non-compliant applications may be excluded from the competition, at the sole discretion of the committee.

Communications

The prize winner will be contacted by e-mail and/or telephone by the organizers, who will notify the outcome of the committee's evaluation. If the recipient is not found or does not accept the prize within 7 days of notification, the Organization may decide to revoke the prize and/or reassign it to another candidate. The judgment of the Committee and the Organization's application of these regulations are final.

The name of the winning candidate may be publicized through the official channels of the Organization and, if necessary, through the press. Date and place of the award ceremony will be communicated directly to the winner and will be on the dates and at the venue of the Conference. The winner must guarantee his or her presence at the award ceremony, which will take place as part of the Conference.

In that context, the winner of the first prize will be required to briefly present his or her work to the audience present in the hall.
